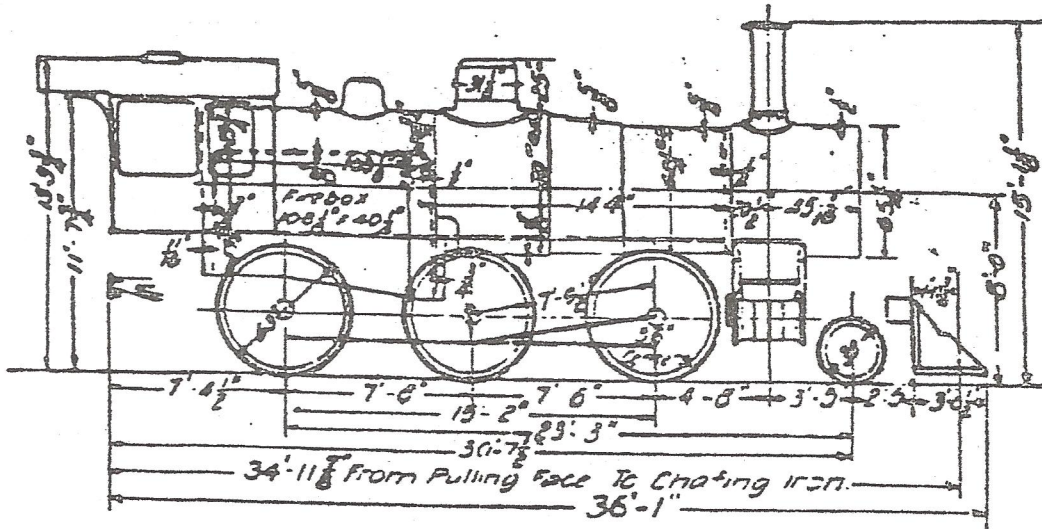

ENGINE NUMBER 1629

This steam locomotive was manufactured in Schenectady, New York in 1900. Purchased by the Southern Pacific Railroad, it was used on the line which ran from Yuma, Arizona to Portland, Oregon, often passing through this valley.

It was retired in 1957 and sold to Mr. Gene Autry, who had it moved to his Melody Ranch in Placerita Canyon, to be used in numerous television and motion picture productions. Damaged in a fire twelve years later Engine No. 1629 sat on a back lot until 1981 when Mr. Autry donated it to the Santa Clarita Valley Historical Society who had it moved, again, to its present location next to the Saugus Station.
